Appointments at Win Clinic

TA21 9HX

Win Clinic is located just behind Willowbrook Garden Centre on the A38 between Wellington and Taunton, 5 minutes from M5 Jct 26. Exit M5 and head towards Wellington. Take the 4th exit off the first roundabout you come to and follow signs to Taunton. As you come down the hill and around the bend, Willowbrook Garden Centre is on the right. Turn right, but go past the entrance to the Garden Centre. About 50 yards along the road, on the right, is a gravel layby, with a sign for the Win Clinic and H2O Canine Hydrotherapy: just before the speed restriction sign. Turn right in through the metal gates. Please park where you find space.

Win Clinic is to the right of the hydrotherapy pool. You are welcome to wander round the car park or walk in the lane, if required. Please pick up after your dog. There are Poo bins on site. Then make your way to the reception room, and wait for Nicky or Caroline to meet you there. Please do not walk along the corridor, as there may be other dogs having treatment.

Appointments at Dogs at Donyatt

Dogs at Donyatt is located on the A358 in Donyatt. Donyatt Garage, Ilminster.

From Ilminster, enter Donyatt and pass the pub on your left. 100 yds on the right you will see a sign for Dogs at Donyatt. Turn in and at the top of the lane turn left. Go past the new houses, and the car park is situated at the end of the gravel lane.

From Chard, once you have gone over the small bridge the village hall will be on your left. The turning is on the left immediately after the 3 new houses. Follow the lane to the top, go past the new houses and the car park is at the end of the gravel lane.

Your physiotherapist will come out to meet you. There is at present no reception area, and there may be other animals being treated. You are welcome to wander round the car park, and the lane, but please keep your dog on a lead and pick up at all times.

Appointments last between 45 minutes to an hour.
